

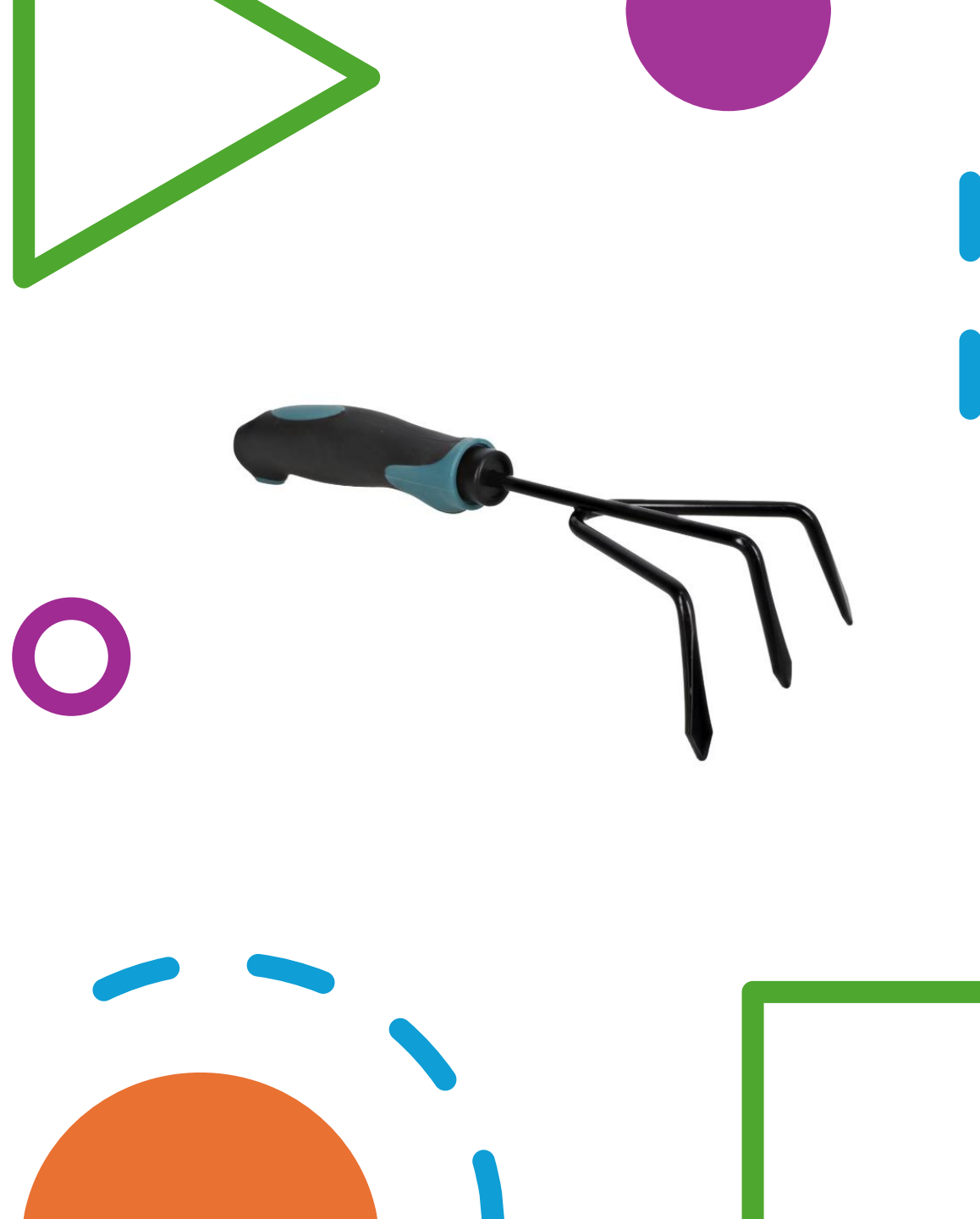


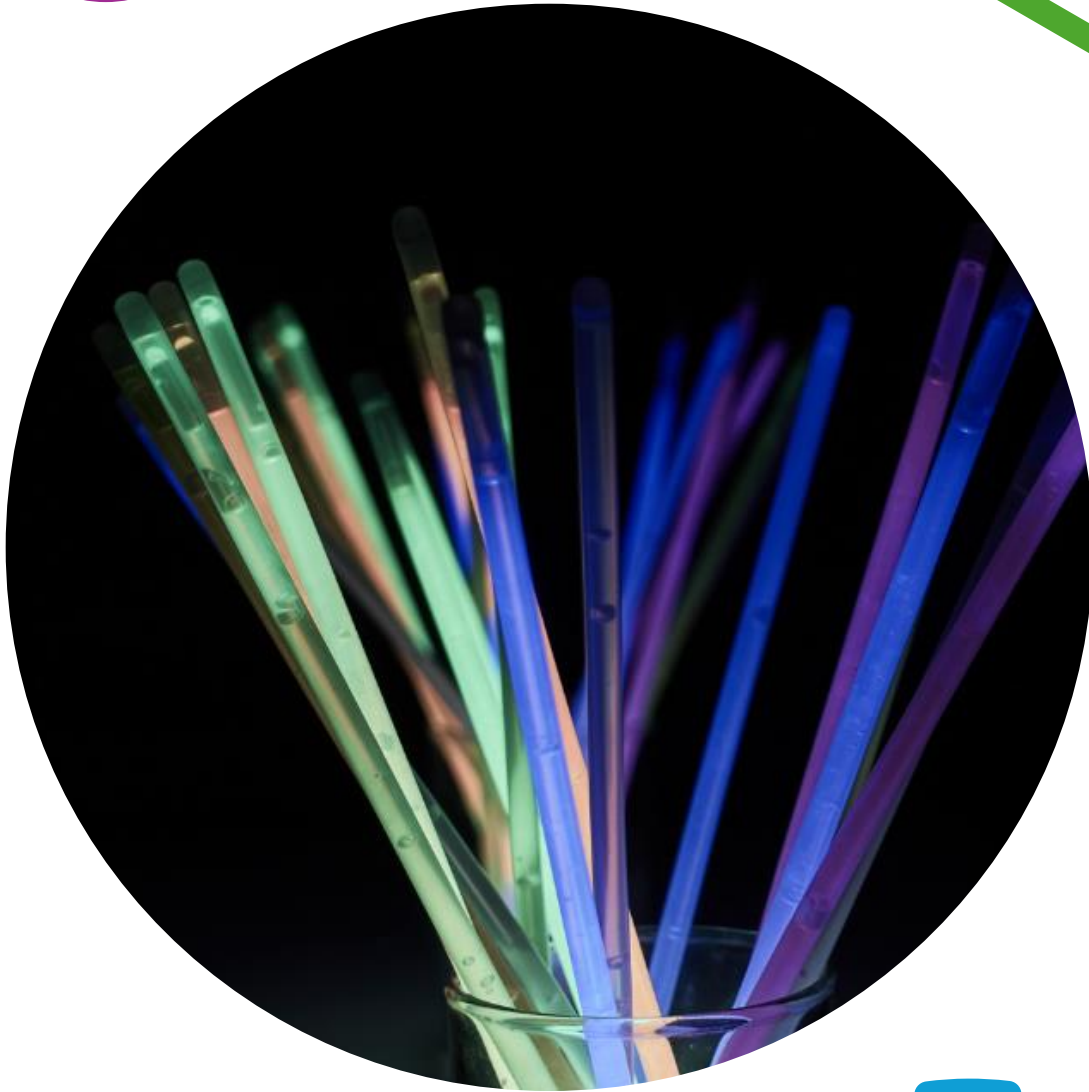

# Bright Flower Seeds

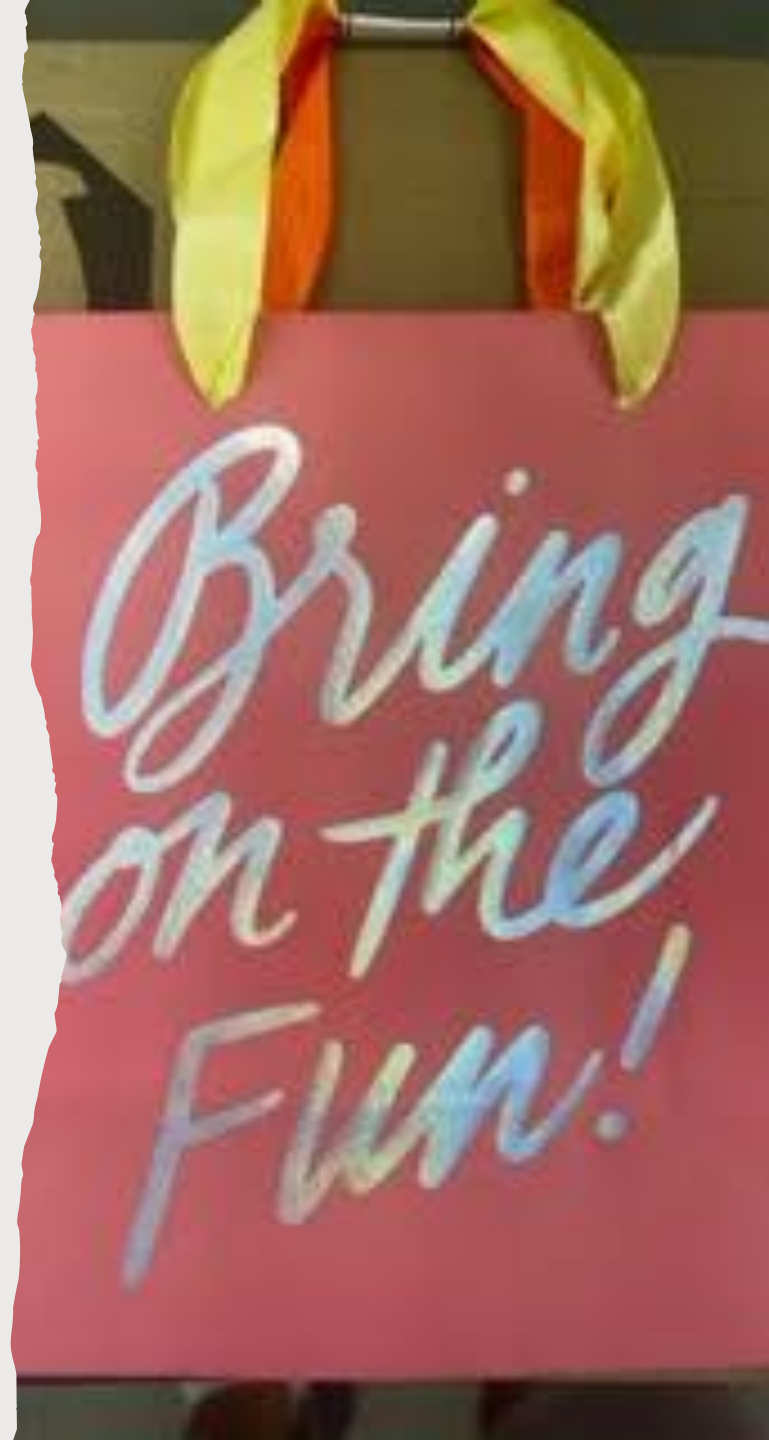
For the person who invests in the development of others or those who brighten up the workplace and bring a breath of fresh air.

For that person that is always pulling us when we are broken down and in tough situations. For that special person that always lifts others and pulls them to a safe place.

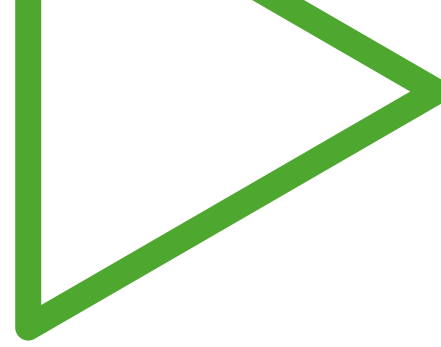
# Tissues
